God	Said Allah does not like the disbelievers. (Qur'an 3:32, 22:38)	Said God loves everyone. (John 3:16)
Assurance of Paradise after death	"Though I am the Apostle of Allah, yet I do not know what Allah will do to me." (Sahih Bukhari: Volume 5, Book 58, Number 266)	"Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him" (John 3:36)
Sin	Stoned women for adultery. (Muslim 4206)	"Let he who is without sin cast the first stone." (John 8:3-11)
Theft	Permitted stealing from unbelievers. (Bukhari 44:668)	"Thou shalt not steal." (Matthew 19:18)
Lying	Permitted lying. (Sahih Muslim 6303, Bukhari 49:857)	"Thou shalt not bear false witness." (Matthew 19:18)
Forgiveness	Killed those who insulted him. (Bukhari 4:241)	Preached forgiveness. (Matthew 18:21-22, 5:38)
Revenge	"If then anyone transgresses the prohibition against you, Transgress ye likewise against him" (Qur'an 2:194)	"If someone strikes you on the right cheek, turn to him the other also." (Matthew 5:39)
Marriage	Married 13 wives and kept sex slaves. (Bukhari 5:268, Qur'an 33:50)	Was celibate.
War	Ordered 65 military campaigns and raids in his last 10 years. (Ibn Ishaq)	Ordered no military campaigns, nor offered any approval of war or violence. Chastised anyone attempting to defend him with force. (John 18:10-12)
Serving	Demanded captured slaves and a fifth of all other loot taken in war. (Qur'an 8:41)	"The Son of Man came not to be served, but to serve." (Matthew 20:28) Washed his disciples feet. (John 13:5)
Enemies	"And fight them until there is no more persecution and religion is only for Allah" (Qur'an 8:39)	"Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you" (Matthew 5:44)
Greatest Commandments	"Belief in Allah and Jihad in His cause" (Muslim 1:149)	"Love God and love your neighbor as yourself." (Matthew 22:34-40)
Protection	Demanded the protection of armed bodyguards, even in a house of worship (Qur'an 4:102)	Chastised anyone attempting to defend him with force. (John 18:10-12)
Hearing from God	He heard from God (through an angel)	When he heard from God he went to the desert to be tempted and began his ministry with boldness, (Mark 1:7-15).
Identity	He claimed to be a man.	He claimed to be God as well as a man. (John 8:24;8:58)

Instructions Received	From an angel	From God the Father (John 5:19)
Ministry	He received it from an angel (Gabriel). He received his words in the darkness of a cave.	He received his calling from God directly (Matt. 3:17). Jesus received his commission in the daylight.
Ministry Length	Muhammad taught for more than 20 years	Jesus taught for 3 1/2 years
Miracles	Muhammad's only miracle was the Quran.	Jesus performed many miracles including healing people, calming a storm with a command, and raising people from the dead.
Sacrifice	Muhammad saved his own life many times and had others killed.	Jesus voluntarily laid his life down for others
Sin	Muhammad was a sinner (Quran 40:55; 48:1-2)	Jesus never sinned (1 Pet. 2:22)
Voice of God	Muhammad did not receive or hear the direct voice of God. It was an angel instead.	Jesus received and heard the direct voice of God (Mark 1:10-11)
Women	Muhammad said women were 1/2 as smart as men (Hadith 3:826; 2:541), that the majority in hell will be women (Had. 1:28,301; 2:161)	Jesus spoke well of women
